MENA has delivered unprecedented infrastructure scale. The next challenge is not building more. It is sustaining and optimising what exists.

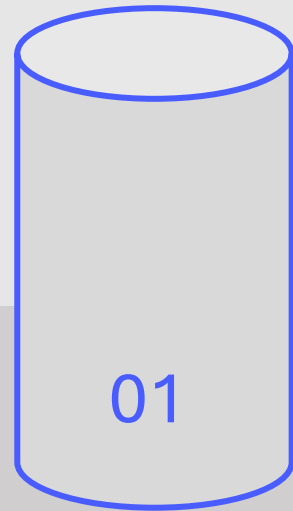
Capital is Now Moving Toward

MENA Construction Summit 2026 addresses where this capital is being allocated and how contractors, operators, vendors and asset owners can position themselves.

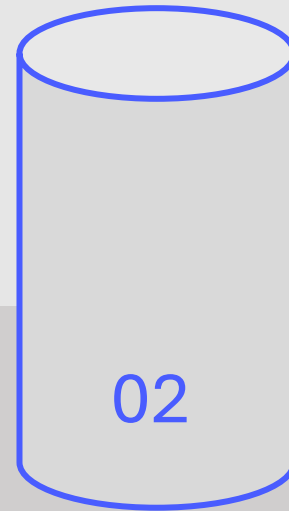

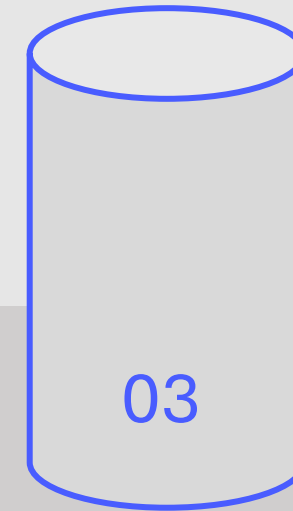
Operational Excellence & Asset Performance
